## A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF SHELLBROOK TO ISSUE WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES

The Council of the Town of Shellbrook in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. On the advice of the Water Treatment Plant Operator or his designate the:
  - a) Chief Administrative Officer

- b) Chief Administrative Officer's Designate
- c) Water Treatment Plant Operator or,
- d) Water Treatment Plant Operator's Designate

may issue water conservation measures for any consumers of water provided by the Town of Shellbrook Water Treatment Plant.

- 2. The water conservation measures may include but are not limited to restrictions for the use of water for grass, gardens, swimming pools, or any outdoor use of water.
- 3. The issuance of water conservation measures will be made by posting a notice in the Town Office Post Office and website stating the details of the water restrictions and the effective date
- 4. Anyone found to be in contravention of a water conservation measure restriction issued pursuant to this bylaw may have their water connection terminated without notice and be fined not more than \$2,500.00.
