Bylaw No. 2018-04

A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 2012-06 known as the Official Community Plan of the Town of Shellbrook.

The Council of the Town of Shellbrook, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts this bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 2012-06 as follows:

1. The **Future Land Use Concept** referred to in Section 5 is amended:
 - a. By redesignating a portion of the SE ¼ Sec 16-49-03-W3M from Future Commercial to Future Residential, as shown within the bold dashed line on "Schedule A", which is attached and forms part of the this bylaw.
2. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect when approved by of the Minister of Government Relations.

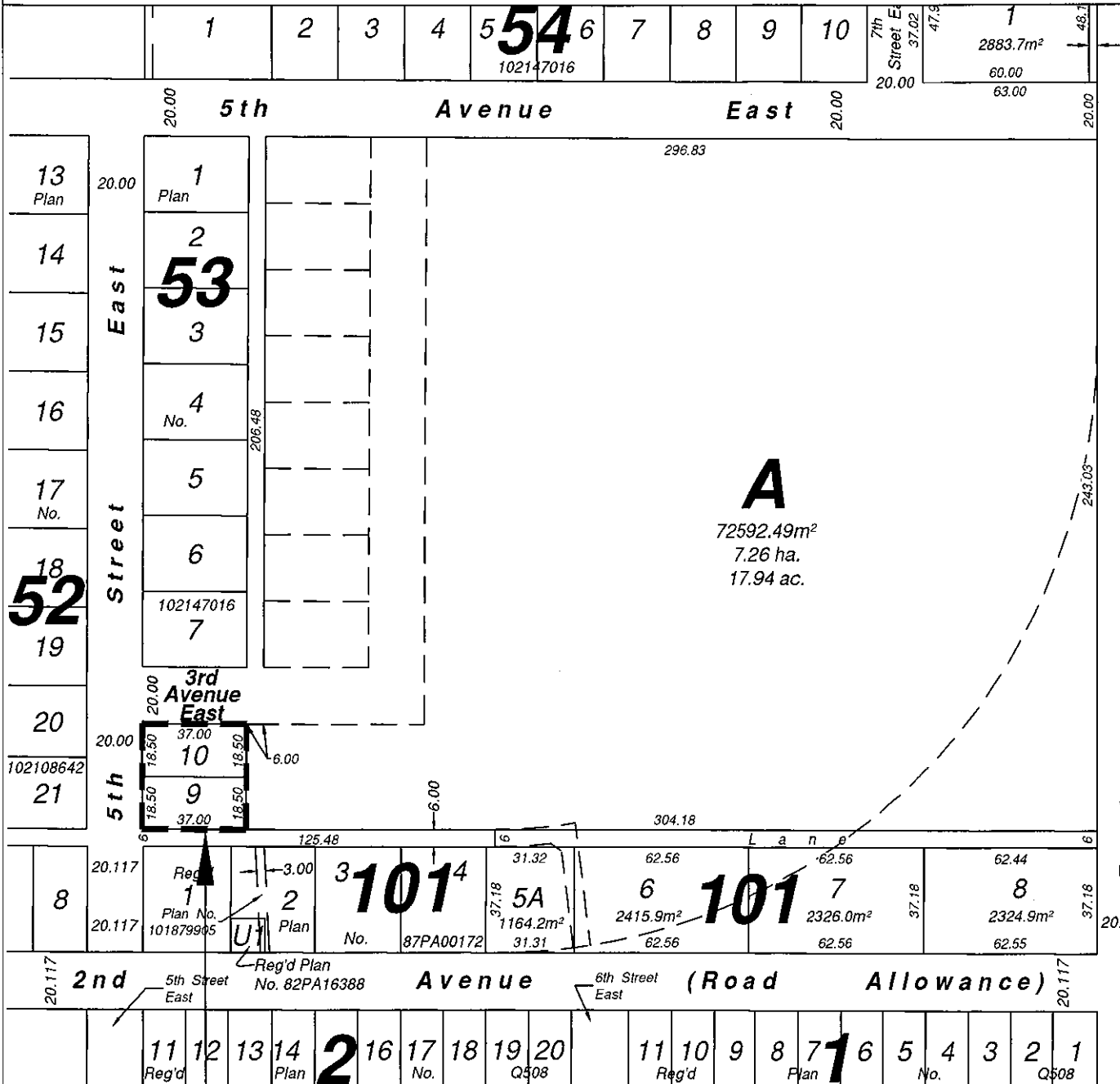
