


FIRE FIGHTING AGREEMENT BYLAW

A Bylaw of the Town of Shellbrook to enter into an agreement with the Rural Municipality of Canwood #494 in regard to providing mutual support for fire fighting operations.


THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SHELLBROOK ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Town of Shellbrook is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw and identified as Exhibit "A" with the Rural Municipality of Canwood #494 for the purpose stated within the agreement.
2. The Mayor and the Administrator of the Town of Shellbrook are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached identified as Exhibit "A".

Between: The Town of Shellbrook,
 in the Province of Saskatchewan

And: The Rural Municipality of Canwood #494 of Canwood,
 in the Province of Saskatchewan

1) The municipalities named in this agreement agree to provide fire protection in the form of men and equipment to property located within the corporate boundaries and under the municipal jurisdiction of each party to this agreement when the fire chief or his designate deems it necessary and desirable.

2) Each municipality signing this agreement agrees to accept the invoice for any firecall services provided by itself and in turn invoice the actual recipient of the service for the charges. If the charges referred to remain unpaid by the recipient of the service sixty days after the service is received, the municipality in which the recipient's property is located will pay the charges to the municipality which provides the said service.

3) The parties to this agreement further agree that in the event back up fire protection support is required at a fire that the fire chief or his designate of the municipality concerned be authorized to call for this support when he deems it necessary and payment for this protection shall be guaranteed in the same manner as outlined in item (2) above.

4) It is further understood that in the event of a fire that the first fire chief on the scene shall be deemed to be in charge of the situation unless the fire chief from the municipality in which the fire has occurred arrives after the fire chief of a neighbouring municipality in which case the fire chief of the municipality concerned should have control of the situation.

5) It is understood by both parties to this agreement that the said agreement does not refer to calls made to Indian Reserves.
