DUE TO COVID-19, please note the following Rules in place for Voting at the Polls:

- Please follow the entry protocols at the Shellbrook Community Hall that are currently in place.
- Masks are STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.
- HAND SANITIZER is available upon entry into the building and IS MANDATORY!
- Physical distancing (2 meters apart) will be required. Please obey all signs & arrows
- Single-use pencils will be available, please dispose of after you have cast your ballot
- Surfaces will be regularly disinfected throughout the day
- Voter Registration Forms (FORM R) are available on the Town website at <u>www.townofshellbrook.ca</u> to print off or available to be picked up beforehand at the Town Office.
- <u>Please follow the entry protocols at the Shellbrook Community Hall that are currently in place.</u> Filling in this document at home will save time and exposure at the polls.

Forms are available at the Town Office or online to be printed at www.townofshellbrook.ca until November 8, 2020.

MAIL-IN BALLOT PROCEDURE

- Go to <u>www.townofshellbrook.ca</u> under Municipal Services > Election > Election
 Mail-in Ballot Package is available and may be completed at the Town Office.
- <u>Complete</u> both Form R and Form C <u>EXCEPT signature</u>. Your signature must be witnessed by a Commissioner of Oaths, Notary Public, a lawyer, **OR** the Returning Officer (Kelly Hoare) to be valid and receive your ballot.
- Return forms by mail <u>IF</u> witnessed by other than Returning Officer <u>OR</u> to the Town Office.
- Ballots, envelopes, and instructions will then be provided to you. Once you have received your ballot, you are not entitled to vote at any other poll.
- Ballots must be received by the Returning Officer by November 8, 2020. They
 must be returned by regular mail, registered mail, courier or in person.
