

BYLAW NO. 2-1971

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF SHELLBROOK AUTHORIZING COUNCIL OF
THE SAID TOWN TO ENTER INTO A HOUSING AGREEMENT

WHEREAS provisions is made in the Housing and Urban Renewal Act, 1966 Chapter 53, R.S.S. 1966, enabling the Council of any Municipality, subject to the approval of the Local Government Board, to enter into a Housing agreement or Agreements as contemplated by Section 4 of the said Act, and WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Shellbrook deems it expedient to undertake a Housing Project within the terms of the said Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Shellbrook enacts as follows:

- (1) That the proposed agreement herunto annexed and marked as Schedule "A" to this Bylaw and which is deemed to be part of this Bylaw, being a tripartite Agreement between:

BETWEEN:

HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF CANADA

represented by the Honourable Robert K. Andras, Minister

Under the National Housing Act, 1954

(hereinafter called "the Federal Minister")

OF THE FIRST PART:

AND:

HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF SASKATCHEWAN

represented by the Honourable Allan R. Guy,

Minister of Municipal Affairs.

(hereinafter called "the Provincial Minister")

-and-

CENTRAL MORTGAGE AND HOUSING CORPORATION

(hereinafter called "the corporation")

(JOINTLY hereinafter called "the Partnership")

OF THE SECOND PART:

AND:

THE TOWN OF SHELLBROOK

(hereinafter called "the Town")

OF THE THIRD PART:

(2) That the Mayor and the Town Administrator for the Town of Shellbrook be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to sign the said Agreements on behalf of the Town and affix thereto the corporate seal of the Town.

(3) That this Bylaw shall come into force on the day of its approval by the Local Government Board.
