Town of Shellbrook Bylaw No. 2020-05

A Bylaw of the Town of Shellbrook to repeal the designation of a site as a Municipal Heritage Property

The Council of the Town of Shellbrook in the Province of Saskatchewan, pursuant to The Municipalities Act, enacts as follows:

WHERAS Sections 11 and 12 of *The Heritage Property Act* authorize the Council of a Municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings, features and structures thereon, to be of heritage value; and,

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Shellbrook previously designated the property known as:

The Shellbrook CN Railway Station/Shellbrook Museum, located at 99 Railway Ave, Shellbrook, SK (Pt. NW9-49-3-W3rd Meridian).

As Municipal Heritage Property by Bylaw # 1988-06 read a third time and passed by the Council of the Municipality on the 15th day of August, 1988.

WHEREAS Sections 17 and 18 of *The Heritage Property Act* authorize the Council of a Municipality to enact bylaws to repeal designation of real property; and,

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Shellbrook has caused, not less than thirty (30) days prior to consideration of this bylaw, a Notice of Intention to Repeal to be:

- a) Served on the owners of said property;
- b) Served on the Registrar of Heritage Property; and,
- c) Published in on issue of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality; and,

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed repeal of designation has been served on the Council of the Municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality enacts as follows:


1. There is repealed Bylaw No 1989-07, enacted on the 3rd of April, 1989 to designate as Municipal Heritage Property the real property legally described as;

Pt. NW9-49-3-W3rd Meridian.

The reasons for the repeal being as follows:

- 1. Due to the age of the building and cost to upgrade to bring it up to code and make the building safe and useable, is too costly for our community.
- 2. The Municipal Administrator/Clerk is hereby authorized to:
 - a. Discharge any interest based on the notice of designation that was registered in the Land Titles; and,
 - b. Notify all property owners of the repeal.
- 3. The Municipal Administrator/Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of the bylaw to be served on the Registrar of Heritage Property.

Read a third time and passed this 18th day of October, 2021
