Phone Tree System

The Town of Shellbrook will be implementing our new Phone Tree system in the fall of 2013. This service will inform residents of our town of important events that may affect them, such as water main breaks. An automated message by phone, text or email will be sent to you. Please contact the office to ensure we have correct contact information for you.

Missed Garbage Pickup

If your street or house are missed for garbage pickup, please call the Town office the Monday following and a truck will be sent out to collect it. Also, please ensure your bin is at least three feet away from your neighbor's bin or vehicles.

Utility Billing: Payments

Please make payments from an ATM or banking institution at least 7-10 days before the **last business day** of the month to allow adequate time for the bank to process and send us the information. Payments are only applied when they are received **in office**. Payments can also be made at the municipal office between 9 am - 4 pm at 71 Main Street by cash, cheque or debit. If that is inconvenient we have a drop off box located by the front door for after hour payments which are entered in our system the next business day.

Utility Billing: Changes

Water/sewer bills are now going out monthly. Meters will be read quarterly; commencing in January 2014. Additional meter reads can be accommodated at the owner's request for an additional \$25 fee + GST.

The Town of Shellbrook will only pick up leaves, grass and branches in Bio-degradable bags. These bags can be purchased at the office for \$1.00 + GST. If you have a different supplier of bio bags, please contact the office to ensure that they are acceptable at our land fill. Some of these bags take up to 2 years to start decomposing.
