2013 Tax Discount Rates

The Town of Shellbrook's tax discount rates have changed for the 2013 year. As of January 1, the discount rates are:

January 2013	10%
February 2013	9%
March 2013	8%
April 2013	7%
May 2013	6%
June 2013	5%

July-December 2013 there will be **NO DISCOUNT.**

Tax pre-payments for 2013 will be based on last year's levy. To take full advantage of the discount rates you may pay any amount you desire during the applicable months listed above. Levy will be set upon approval of the budget which is usually approved in late spring.

Also, BID and Sask Rivers school division no longer offer a discount. The discount is only applicable to municipal taxes.

2014 Pet and Business Licenses

Starting January 1, 2014 the Town of Shellbrook will no longer provide automatic billing for pet licenses. Watch for more information!

Snow Removal

The Town of Shellbrook would like to remind its residents that clearing the streets is one of our top priorities.

To help with our street clearing endeavors, we would ask that residents please refrain from parking in areas where the snow plow or grader is actively removing snow and in areas where there are snow route signs or signs indicating immediate snow removal.

Similarly, we would like to remind you to ask a neighbor or hire someone to shovel

your driveways if you are to be away from your homes for long periods of time. This will help stop the snow and ice from accumulating at the end of your driveway and any problems for vehicle entry or exit.

Also, we would like to remind you to shovel your sidewalks to help our residents stay safe. While shoveling, please ensure that the snow removed from the sidewalks is placed in your yard and not on the street.

Back alleys are plowed when time permits as primary, secondary, and side streets have priority. If you see a clear alley, please note that a resident may have cleared it and not necessarily the Town.
