## Leaves and Grass Clippings

We will continue to pick up leaves and grass clippings providing they are placed in approved bio-degradable or compostable bags. We will again have these bags available at the town office for \$1.00/bag plus GST. They are also available at Home Hardware and various locations in Prince Albert.

Our scheduled day for pickup will be Tuesday, dependent on the weather.

## Utility Billing: Minimum Rates Change

Effective February 2014, the minimum water/sewer rates increased from \$62.90 to \$70.70.

## Tax Discount

There will be a tax discount of 5% if paid by June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2014. This applies only to the municipal portion.

## Assessment Roll

The assessment roll will remain open for inspection until 4pm on June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2014. Assessment information can also be viewed on SAMAvue. Your official tax notice will be in the mail prior to June 30, 2014.

## Bylaw Tidbits

Please be courteous of your neighbors and keep your yards neat and your unhitched boats and trailers off of the streets. These contravene our bylaws and could result in a visit from our bylaw officer. We receive many complaints throughout the year on these two items.

## Driveway Paving

When the paving crew is through, they will have some time to pave driveways. The estimated cost will be \$45/m<sup>2</sup>

This is an approximate cost and will depend on the condition of the site. If you are interested in having your driveway paved, please leave your name and number with us at the office.

The date the crew will be through has not been set as of yet.
