BYLAW NO. 1 - 1992

GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW

The Council of the Town of Shellbrook in the Province of Saskatchewan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This bylaw shall be known and referred to as the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town.
2. Section 3 shall apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the town for which no other fine is provided and which such bylaw states, shall incur the fines herein provided.
3. Subject to the provisions of Section 2 of this bylaw any person found guilty of an infraction of any bylaw of the Town of Shellbrook, passed pursuant to the authority of the Urban Municipality Act 1984 or any other Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than:
 - (a) \$2,000.00 in the case of an individual;
 - (b) \$5,000.00 in the case of a corporation;
 - (c) \$ 250.00 per day in the case of a continuing offense.
4. All fines imposed for an infraction of a bylaw shall, unless otherwise provided for, belong to the town for the public use and form part of the general revenue of the town.
5. Bylaw No. 6 - 1970 is hereby repealed.
