

Town of Shellbrook Bylaw No. 4 - 2002

A Bylaw of the Town of Shellbrook to amend The Town's Fire Prevention Bylaw (Bylaw 4-1993) to provide for the issuing of total bans on open fires.

The Council of the Town of Shellbrook in the Province of Saskatchewan, pursuant to Section 136 of The Urban Municipality Act, 1984, enacts as follows:

1. That the following be added to Bylaw 4 - 1993 immediately following Section 2 (4):
 - (4.1) Not withstanding Subsection (4) the Mayor or Fire Chief shall be empowered to issue an order to establish a total ban on all open fires within the boundaries of the Town of Shellbrook.
2. That Section 5. of the said Bylaw No. 4 - 1993 hereby be repealed and the following inserted in its place:
 5. Penalties:
 - (1) Any person or corporation that contravenes any provision of any order made pursuant to Section 2 (4.1) of this bylaw shall, on summary conviction, be subject to a penalty of not more than \$2,000 in the case of an individual or a penalty of not more than \$10,000 in the case of a corporation.
 - (2) Any person or corporation that contravenes any provision of this Bylaw, with the exception of orders issued under Section 2. (4.1), is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Shellbrook, as amended from time to time.
