A Bylaw of the Town of Shellbrook to authorize the addition of interest to outstanding accounts receivable.

The Council of the Town of Shellbrook, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enact as follows:

1. On the 1st day of each month, interest, equal to 2% of the outstanding balance, shall be added to all accounts receivable remaining unpaid more than 30 days after the original invoice date.
