**BYLAW NUMBER 2018-09**

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF SHELLBROOK TO ISSUE WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES**

The Council of the Town of Shellbrook in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. On the advice of the Water Treatment Plant Operator or his designate the:
  - a) Chief Administrative Officer
  - b) Chief Administrative Officer's Designate
  - c) Water Treatment Plant Operator or,
  - d) Water Treatment Plant Operator's Designate

may issue water conservation measures for any consumers of water provided by the Town of Shellbrook Water Treatment Plant.

2. The water conservation measures may include but are not limited to restrictions for the use of water for grass, gardens, swimming pools, or any outdoor use of water.
3. The issuance of water conservation measures will be made by posting a notice in the Town Office, Post Office and website stating the details of the water restrictions and the effective date.
4. Anyone found to be in contravention of a water conservation measure restriction issued pursuant to this bylaw may have their water connection terminated without notice and be fined not more than \$2,500.00.
