Shut Off Valves

Repairing your inside shut off valve can save you \$\$\$\$. Currently, if you have issues with your valve inside the house, our cost to shut off water at the curb is \$75.00, plus a possible call out charge.

Garbage & Recycle Bins

To ensure pick up, set out the recycle or garbage bins prior to **6:30 am on Fridays**. Remove the bins promptly after pickup as they interfere with street cleaning.

E-cycling

There will be an E-cycling collection depot for unwanted electronics and appliances on **Saturday, May 27, 2017 from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the Scout Hall in the campground.**

Clean up days

This year we will be trying something new for cleanup days. The landfill will now be open on the **3rd Saturday of the month from May 20th to October 21st from 12:00 noon to 4:00 p.m.** Only clean wood, leaves, tree trimmings, grass clipping and garden refuse will be accepted. Anyone depositing anything other than these items will be subject to a fine!

Contractors

If you hire contractors & businesses, they are required to have a business license to work within town limits. This includes plumbers, builders, electricians, heating, etc. Licenses are purchased at the Town Office. If they are from Prince Albert they can purchase an inter-municipal license at the City office which is good in Shellbrook, Prince Albert, Duck Lake and Rosthern.



Pet Licenses

All dogs and cats require pet licenses and tags and must not be left wandering about in town. Cats picked up will attract the same penalty as dogs. 2017 tags and licenses are available at the town office.



Cats

Cats just like dogs are not permitted to take a walk alone. They must also be kept within their owner's property. Please ensure that they are confined inside an enclosure or on a leash. Stiff penalties exist for cats as well as dogs that are picked up. Also, please refrain from feeding stray cats and call the town office if you see any hanging around your residence. Feeding them assumes ownership & they become nuisances to neighbors.
