## **Plastic Containers, Milk Cartons & Plastic Milk Jugs**

- \*Plastics numbered 2 through 7, no food containers labelled #1.
- \*No oil containers or chemical jugs, no plastic wrap or bags.



## **Tin and Aluminum Cans**

\*Cans must be clean, with or without labels – no steel or auto parts.
